As I listen through books of the Bible on my audio Bible application, I am amazed at how no matter where I am in the Scriptures everything always correlates. I have seen God cause the threat of dangerous floods to dissipate until I am safely home. It reminds me of the miracles God performed while Israel was in the Sinai desert for 40 years. One profound thing about Israel's journey through the desert was their ability to survive in a place with little to no water. As a very large tribe, this feat is nearly impossible, especially for forty years! However, God is faithful to His people. God caused manna, bread from above, to fall down every day and feed the Israelites. He also caused Moses to command a rock to bring forth water when the people had nothing to drink.

In the New Testament, God performed even more great signs for God's people. Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead after four days out of a stinky tomb! He walked on water, caused storms to subside, supernaturally multiplied food, caused blind men to see, and performed many other miracles. Jesus' disciples, who later became the apostles and builders of the early Church, followed suit performing signs and healing many through God's power within them. Today, the Church is still called to have the same kind of faith in God which enabled Moses and the early disciples to demonstrate God's power.

As you walk with God, remember Who it is you are walking with. He is the God who supernaturally delivered Israel and the Jews from the bondage of Pharaoh in Egypt. He is the God who sent His Son Jesus to bring hope of eternal life into the world. He is the God who has healed many and continues to today. He is El Shaddai (the Hebrew word for "God Almighty"). His power is infinite! With one volcano He can blast new land forms into existence. With one word He can cause dangerous storms to calm. With one touch He can heal any part of your life that is broken.
